Dear Mr. Haverkamp,

every step that Slovenské elektrárne has taken in the Environmental Impact Assessment process has been in line with our Transparency Policy and strictly in line with the law and international conventions. Also, I would like to assure you that Slovenské elektrárne has been making all efforts to ensure that the public consultation process on the EIA for Operation of Units 3 and 4 of the Mochovce NPP is conducted fully in line with best national and international practice.

As you know, responsibilities for the EIA process are split among various subjects, such as concerned municipalities, ministries, and the proponent – Slovenské elektrárne. As the proponent, SE has already agreed to take part on public hearings at any convenient place, resulting in one hearing organized in Bratislava on Sept 18th and second in Vienna on Sept 25th. Slovenské elektrárne uses all means to make the whole process as transparent as possible, with respect to legal and best practice principles that do not allow us to exclude any public from the consultation process, or take restrictive measures which would preclude public to discuss the EIA Report.

We would like you to join us in a constructive discussion during the public hearing.
